

# WHAT IS A FILM COMPETITION?

A film competition is an exciting and fast-paced event where teams of filmmakers create a short film from start to finish within just 48 hours!

#### **HOW IT WORKS**

**KICK-OFF** 

**Receive a theme:** Start with a specific theme or genre that your film must incorporate.

SCRIPTWRITING

**Brainstorm and plan:** Quickly brainstorm ideas, develop a story, and write a script.

**3** FILMING

**Shoot the film:** Using a smartphone or other professional equipment, film your short movie.

4 EDITING

**Post-Production:** Edit your footage, add music and sound effects, and polish your film.

**5** SUBMISSION

**Meet the deadline:** Submit your completed film before the deadline.

#### THINGS TO KNOW

- All skill levels are eligible
- First 24 teams to register get to compete
- Professional production studio onsite
- Only females allowed behind the camera
- Must be 17 or older to lead a team
- Actors and extras can be male
- · Must fill out all required forms
- Must be family friendly: no cursing, inappropriate scenes, etc.

#### **IMPORTANT DATES**

- Short film parameters provided at the Orientation Meeting on July 22, 2024
- Competition time: August 2-4, 2024
- All films must be submitted on August 4th by 7:00PM
- Awards presented at premiere of movies on August 24, 2024

# **FAQs**

#### Q Who sees the films?

A The film will be shown at the premiere on August 24, 2024 at 4:00 PM. The audience will consist of other filmmakers that are competing, family, friends, and anyone invited.

## Q Is there a limit to the number of people on a team?

A No. There is no limit to team members, as long as the actual filmmakers consist of only women.

## Am I allowed to be on more than one team?

A Yes, you're allowed.

## Q Does the maximum length of the film include credits?

A Yes. Credits are included in the length of the film.

## Are your own videos and photos allowed?

A Yes. This also applies to music, as long as it is paid for and legally obtained.

# Q Do I need to subtitle my film during the project weekend?

A If the film is in a language other than English, subtitles are needed. Otherwise, subtitles are not required.

### **Q** What's a logline?

A Longlines are a very short summary or description of the story.

## Can we make a poster and/or trailer to share on social media?

A Yes! Posters or trailers are not required, but if a team has the ability to make a trailer or poster they may. These trailers could be used by teams to invite their friends or family to come to the premiere.
